

The Caledonia Ambulance Service (MN) is accepting applications for the position of Emergency Medical Technician. Caledonia Ambulance Service is a progressive basic life support service which runs about 400 calls per year. This position requires a minimum of a High school diploma or GED. Candidates must also have completed an accredited E M T course and hold a current MN certificate or be eligible to obtain certification through the EMSRB of Minnesota or National Registry. This position is considered scheduled on-call. Compensation is paid for on-call time in addition to hourly wage during ambulance runs. New hires are strongly encouraged to seek residency to maintain response requirements.

The Caledonia Ambulance Service also offers a ride along program and assistance to individuals that are interested in becoming future EMT's.
